## GENERAL PROVISIONS

The prices, stated below, are recommendation. In some hunting grounds they can be changed. Hunting guests will be informed accordingly in advance.

The invoice for services rendered is issued in euro. It may, however, be paid also in other convertible currencies.

Trophies are being evaluated while fresh, according to the respective formula of the International Council for Game and Wildlife Conservation (CIC); therefore, 10% are deducted from the weight of red deer, fallow deer and roe deer trophies.

Cloven-hoofed game and bear may only be taken with a rifle. For other game species shotguns may be used as well. The use of semiautomatic hunting guns, both rifles and shotguns, is only allowed, if they are loaded with two cartridges at the most.

The minimal caliber, bullet weight and hitting power (in Joule) are stated below:

For the following game species shot of the stated minimal diameter may be used:

Hare, pheasant, mallard \_\_\_\_\_ 3,0 mm

During hunting, the hunting guest has to follow the instructions of his stalking guide and only shoot at the game that he has pointed out. If the hunting guest shoots or wounds a game animal without having obtained the approval from the stalking guide, he has to pay an indemnity, amounting to the double bag fee.

The daily hunting fee covers:

1. For bear, red deer, roe deer, chamois, mouflon, fallow deer and wild boar hunting - organization of the hunt, admission to the hunting ground, fee for the stalking guide, use of hunting constructions and handling of the trophy;
2. For small game hunting - organization of the hunt, admission to the hunting ground, fee for the stalking guide and use of a gun-dog.

Boars and lodging have to be paid for separately.

For ordered transportation by car an allowance, amounting to 0,25 €/km has to be paid.

Venison of the taken game animals can be purchased at the daily price.

## RED DEER



**Shooting-season:**

**Stag - from 16<sup>th</sup> August to 31<sup>st</sup> December; troating from 15<sup>th</sup> September to 5<sup>th</sup> October;**

**Hinds - from 1<sup>st</sup> September to 31<sup>st</sup> December;**

**Calves - from 1<sup>st</sup> September to 31<sup>st</sup> January;**

**Yearling – female and male - from 1<sup>st</sup> July to 31<sup>st</sup> January.**

The daily hunting fee amounts to 50 €.

The indemnity for a wounded, yet not found stag, which the hunting guest has to pay, amounts to 400 € for a trophy of up to 150 points, and to 800 € for trophies above 150 points.

The hunting guest may take with him the trophy and the tushes of the taken stag.

## FALLOW DEER

**Calves - from 1<sup>st</sup> September to 31<sup>st</sup> January;**

**Yearling – female and male from 1<sup>st</sup> July to 31<sup>st</sup> January.**

The daily hunting fee amounts to 50 €.

**Does and kids - from 1<sup>st</sup> September to 31<sup>st</sup> December;**

**Female yearling - from 1<sup>st</sup> May to 31<sup>st</sup> December.**

The daily hunting fee amounts to 50 €.

The indemnity for a wounded, yet not found buck or doe, which the hunting guest has to pay, amounts to 510 €. The indemnity for a wounded, yet not found kid amounts to 160 €.

The hunting guest may take with him the horns and the beard of the taken game.

If the hunting guest wants to take with him the head incl. chest coat of the taken game, he has to pay 50 € in addition; the entire coat costs 80 €.

## MOUFLON



**Shooting-season:**

**ram and lambs - from od 1<sup>st</sup> August to 28<sup>th</sup> February; ewe - from 1<sup>st</sup> August to 31<sup>st</sup> December.**

The daily hunting fee amounts to 50 €.

**sow - from 1<sup>st</sup> July to 31<sup>st</sup> January;**

**gruntling and hogget - from 1<sup>st</sup> January to 31<sup>st</sup> December.**

The daily hunting fee amounts to 50 €.

The indemnity for a wounded, yet not found tusker, which the hunting guest has to pay, amounts to 1,000 €.

The hunting guest may take with him the tusks of the taken tusker.

If the hunting guest wants to take with him the hide incl. The head of the taken tusker, he has to pay a corresponding indemnity at the daily price.

The indemnity for a wounded, yet not found sow, hogget or gruntling amounts to 130 €.

It is also possible to organize a drive hunt. If at least 12 hunting guests take part in such a hunt, each of them pays a lump sum of 200 €.

This payment covers: organization of the hunt, the daily hunting fee and the fee for the taken game. In the case, that the shooting party does not take any game, each hunting guest gets back 50 €.

## SMALL GAME

The daily hunting fee amounts to 50 €.

## PREDATORS

We do not organize separate hunting for predators. If the hunting guest, while hunting for other game species, takes a stone marten, a pine marten or a badger (having obtained for it the permission of his stalking guide), he has to pay a special fee.

## STONE AND PINE MARTEN



**Shooting-season: from 1<sup>st</sup> November to 28<sup>th</sup> February.**

The fee for taking a stone or pine marten amounts to 130 €. The hunting guest may take with him the taken marten.

## BADGER



**Shooting-season: from 1<sup>st</sup> August to 31<sup>st</sup> December.**

The fee for taking a badger amounts to 100 €. The hunting guest may take with him the taken badger.
